

Could Your Pet's Snoring be a Sign of Problems?



Talk to your veterinarian if you observe any of these symptoms in your pet - they may be an indication that your pet needs treatment for a condition called Brachycephalic Obstructive Airway Syndrome (BOAS).



Snoring



Noisy breathing



Gagging while swallowing



Fainting



Coughing up foamy saliva



Difficulty sleeping or propping their head up while resting



Exercise intolerance



Heavy breathing including chest and stomach heaving



Blue tinge to the tongue and gums

These symptoms may be heightened during or following physical activity, in hot environments, or in overweight pets.
